

# Italian Wine Report by Tom Hyland

## Winter 2021/2022

### Barolo "Trèsüri" 2018 - 90

The fruit for this Barolo is sourced from vineyards in Verduno La Morra, and Serralunga. Aromas of tea leaf, morel cherry and cedar. Medium-full with very good concentration, good acidity, medium-full tannins, very good persistence and a finish with distinct notes of brown spice. This is a bit shy and restrained now, but the wine will offer greater character in another 2-3 years; peak in 10-12 years.



### Barolo Cerretta 2018 - 93

Beautiful young garnet of medium deep intensity; aromas of dried morel cherry, tobacco and currant. Medium-full with very good to excellent concentration. Very good acidity, medium-full, graceful tannins, notable persistence; there are notes of tobacco and cumin in the finish. Impressive typicity and complexity, along with beautiful overall harmony. Impressive now, this will improve for 3-5 years, with peak in 10-12 years.

### Barolo Riserva "Ghè" 2016 - 93

Medium intense garnet; aromas of ripe black cherry, licorice and notes of forest floor. Medium-full with very good to excellent concentration. Evident oak notes, medium-full tannins, good acidity and notable persistence. This is very young and needs several more years to round out; peak in 12-15 years.
